- Office visit

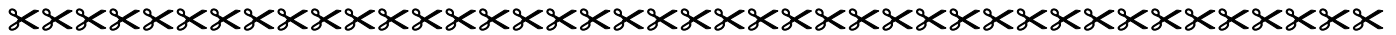
GRADING
